

Camp Information

How to Register

- Mail registration form, payment, staff forms, and camper forms to Mountaintop Church: P.O. Box 2794; Flagstaff, Arizona 86003
- Make all checks payable to: **Native American Fellowship**
- All funds are non-refundable, **BUT ARE TRANSFERABLE**

Cost: \$ 110.00. First come, first served basis will be used for placement in camp as well. It is possible camp could be closed at the door. **If not pre-registered, call before coming to the campground. You can reach the Camp Director Rev. Jackie Holgate 928-380-7601.**

Dorm Leader Fee: All dorm leaders will pay a flat fee of \$ 25.00 (non-refundable, but transferable) with camp leader's application.

- Camp fees includes lodging, meals Monday –dinner @ 5pm – Friday – breakfast @ 8am, swimming fee, and services.
- We encourage churches to register early to assure them a place at camp. **We are limited to 150 campers/leaders.** All registrations are filled on a first come, first served basis.
- Arrival/Departure Times:
Registrations Starts @ 2pm on the first day of camp. Campers are not to be brought and left at camp until they are properly registered. **The first meal will be at 5pm on the first day of camp.**
Camp ends @ 11am on the last day of camp. No supervision will be provided after 12pm. All campers should depart no later than 12:00pm.

Campers Insurance

All campers that attend the Southwest Youth Camp are covered by the camp's accident insurance, but only on secondary basis. In case of an accident, the camper's family personal insurance company will be billed for any medical related expenses.

One Screened Staff Member is requested for every eight campers (or fraction thereafter) from each church. Staff applicants **MUST** have application turned into the Native American Fellowship Office 3 weeks prior to camp. Please send **ONLY QUALITY STAFF MEMBERS.** All staff must be background checked. This will be kept on file at the NAF office. All camp staff must go through the screening process. **Staff Age: 21 and Older.**

General Camp Rules:

- Campers are under the authority of the camp staff during their stay at camp.
- Campers may not leave the grounds unless:
 - a. Under supervised camp activities.
 - b. A written request by a parent/ guardian is presented at registration and id presented at the time of pickup.
- No visitors during the week.
- Campers are expected to conduct themselves in an appropriate manner at all times and to attend all scheduled functions.
- Cell phone use is permitted at designated times.
